5. Environmental

Our Consultant will write the Environmental policies by the End of December. All information has been collated and scored.

6. Housing

All information gathered and document being written. Discussions over reserve sites was ongoing and seeing as we are over our housing target, even in worst case scenario, we may not have to have reserve sites. This was recommended by Consultants at your Locale.

7. Traffic & Transport

Policies written and sent to Consultant to verify. Transport Data requested AGAIN.

8. Community Facilities

School may have to extend in future under LEA guidelines to a maximum of number of children but housing passed will more than meet the requirements. This is in part due to funding a ensuring the school is viable. Location makes expansion awkward, possibly having to go up in the bungalow enclosed Close.

Village Hall would benefit from expansion to create another hall to hire as it is almost at capacity as is the Church Hall. The Community Pavilion certainly has scope to be rented out when not in use by the Cricket Club – this would ensure revenue for the Community Pavilion owned by the Parish Council.

Once all documents have been looked over by Your Locale, they need to be send to HDC to view. Once checked we can go to public consultation for 6 weeks.

A Special Parish Council meeting will be necessary to give the final OK before public Consultation.
